REGULAR MEETING
August 4, 2014

The regular meeting of the Bristol City Council was held on Monday, August 4, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. Those present were: Board President Atherton, Johnson, Peterson, Farrell and Morehouse. Others present were: Sara Johnson, Dave Kroll and Merrie Atherton. The meeting was called to order by Board President Atherton. Motion was made by Morehouse to approve the minutes from the last regular meeting, second by Peterson. Motion carried. Motion was made by Johnson to approve the agenda, second by Morehouse. Motion carried. Peterson made a motion to pay claims as presented, second by Farrell. Motion carried.

MAINTENANCE: Dave Kroll gave an update on the Maintenance Department. The lights on the Bridge our up! Banners have been installed on Main Street. Thank you to Jamie Kwasniewski and Rich Kroll who helped install the banners. Kroll informed council the JD trimmer broke again. A new trimmer was purchased with a 4 year warranty for less then the cost of repairing the JD trimmer, which had previously been fixed twice last year. The heating element in the water heater in the RV Park went out. Kroll is signed up for Water/Waste Water classes and the exam in Huron and Watertown. The overflow dumpster remains to be a problem with people dumping items that are not accepted. Every time someone brings something not accepted Kroll has been picking it out and hauling it to the landfill costing the city more money. Discussion was held to contact the City Attorney to catch people with a game cam and fine violators. Kids have also been tearing around at the City Shop and someone drove through the Volleyball court making tracks through that as well.

OLD BUSINESS: Sara Johnson gave an update on the Pool. The end of the year party will be held Sunday, August 17th in conjunction with a Sand Volleyball Tournament. The Pool Board is going to try to keep the pool open through August 30th if possible. If kids are dismissed from school early and lifeguards are available they would like to be open for the kids. The Board tabled payloaders/skid steer.
