

**CITY OF BRISTOL**  
**REGULAR MEETING**  
**May 4, 2015**

The regular meeting of the Bristol City Council was held on Monday, May 4, 2015 at 7:00 p.m. Those present were: Board President Atherton, Johnson, Peterson, Farrell, and Morehouse. Others present were: Sara Johnson, Pam Barse, and Merrie Atherton. The meeting was called to order by Board President Atherton. Motion was made by Farrell to approve the minutes from the last regular meeting, second by Morehouse. Motion carried. Motion was made by Morehouse to approve the agenda, second by Johnson. Motion carried. Johnson made a motion to pay claims as presented, second by Farrell. Motion carried.

**GUESTS:** Sara Johnson and Pam Barse were in attendance to represent the Bristol Pool Board. The tentative open date for the pool is June 1<sup>st</sup> depending on weather. They will not have to paint the bottom of the pool this year. They will be doing some painting on the building. Webster will be coming over to clean the bottom of the pool. Currently the Pool Board consists of Robbin Carlson, Jen Witt, Sara Johnson, and Pam Barse. Barb Lone resigned this year, the Board is currently looking for volunteers. New kick boards have been purchased for the upcoming season. Larissa Hansmeier will be instructing swimming lessons, the dates are to be determined. A motion was made by Peterson to approve the Pool Board's recommendations for pool employee hourly pay rates for the 2015 season: Lifeguards: Olivia Lone-\$9.25, Karie Lone-\$9.25, Heather Lone-\$9.00, McClain Lone-\$9.00, Erika Herr-\$8.50, second by Morehouse. Motion carried. They are still waiting on two more to turn in applications. The Pool Board will bring their recommendations to the June meeting on the pending applications.

**MAINTENANCE:** David Kroll, Maintenance Department currently on vacation until May 11<sup>th</sup>. Council Members volunteered to do the daily rounds and open the Rubble site while he is on vacation. County Road 33 was discussed as a concerned citizen spoke to the council about the Road being closed. County Rd 33 will not be closed except for the amount of time it takes to bore under the road.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Unlicensed vehicles will begin getting moved Bullert will get with Dave when Dave gets back from vacation so he knows which ones to tow. Trustee Morehouse gave an update on the HideAway. She has been in contact with the property owner. This request is for the All School Re-Union that is to take place at the Bristol School Gym on July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2015. Motion carried.

**FINANCE OFFICER:** Water accounts were discussed in regards to property owners that do not have the house as their primary residence. It was discussed if the water was on they need to pay water and sewer along with surcharges. Motion was made by Peterson second by Morehouse to accept the April financials. Motion carried.
