

CITY OF BRISTOL  
REGULAR MEETING  
October 6, 2014

The regular meeting of the Bristol City Council was held on Monday, October 6, 2014 at 7:00 p.m. Those present were: Board President Atherton, Peterson, Farrell and Morehouse. Others present were: Jerry Roitsch, Dave Kroll and Merrie Atherton. The meeting was called to order by Board President Atherton. Motion was made by Morehouse to approve the minutes from the last regular meeting, second by Farrell. Motion carried. Motion was made by Farrell to approve the agenda, second by Peterson. Motion carried. Farrell made a motion to pay claims as presented, second by Morehouse. Motion carried.

**GUESTS:** Jerry Roitsch was in attendance to represent the Bristol Cemetery Board. Jerry informed the Board the Cemetery had received a significant donation to pave the roads in the Cemetery. A motion was made by Farrell to maintain the roads for the Cemetery when the necessity arises, second by Peterson. Motion carried.

**MAINTENANCE:** The Board discussed the purchase of a used Snow Plow for the City. Peterson made a motion to purchase the 1998 Chevy 7500 for \$13,000, second by Morehouse. Motion carried. Multiple estimates were reviewed in regards to leasing a skid steer. Surrounding cities were contacted in regards to buying vs leasing. A motion was made by Farrell to lease a Terex skid steer from JGE with a snow bucket, this would allow the city to have a warranty on the equipment, second by Peterson. Motion carried. First Savings Bank will be contacted first to try to do the lease locally. If they are unable to accommodate the lease then the City will go thru JGE. Kroll advised Board we are on Jerry Hemeyer's list for the lagoon and lift station. The State came out and did a sewer inspection. The City did well, just a couple areas to improve on. Kroll advised Arly from Webster was able to help with the Quarterly Report; however the City of Bristol needs a test kit. The pool has been winterized for the year. Dump has been burned. Matt's Tree Service did an estimate on trees to be trimmed. Board discussion it was too much for the City to spend at this time. Decision was made to do only the branches that were a necessity for snow removal. Complaints have been received about people tearing through on the road running between Hansmeier's Mill then pulling out in front of people because there is no stop sign as you are headed North. Farrell made a motion to install a stop sign to prevent them from racing through the intersection, second by Morehouse. Motion carried.

**OLD BUSINESS:** Motion made by Morehouse and second by Peterson to approve Bristol Fire Department's application for a Malt Beverage License and a one day spiking permit as pursuant to SDCL 35-1-5.3 . This request is for the annual pheasant opener banquet that is to take place at the Bristol School Gym on October 18<sup>th</sup>, 2014. Motion carried. The budget committee met September 25, 2014. Members present were: Atherton, and Finance Officer. The committee presented the Board with the 2014 budget. Morehouse made a motion to accept the 2015 budget and approve the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading of Appropriation Ordinance #77, second by Farrell. Motion carried.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Council Pay was reviewed and Members were paid.

**FINANCE OFFICER:**

Motion was made by Peterson second by Farrell to accept the September financials. Motion carried.
